Dr. Benitez is the president of Atlantic NeuroSurgical Specialists and Director of the Endovascular Division. Prior to joining ANS, Dr. Benitez was an Assistant Professor of Neurosurgery at Jefferson Medical College/Thomas Jefferson University Hospital in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Dr. Benitez completed medical school at Georgetown University School of Medicine in Washington, DC, and then completed his neurosurgical residency at Thomas Jefferson University Hospital. Dr. Benitez's fellowship was done in cerebrovascular surgery and interventional neuroradiology. He is board certified in neurosurgery.

Dr. Benitez specializes in both the surgical and endovascular management of cerebrovascular disease. He is the Director of Endovascular Neurosurgery at 2 of New Jersey's comprehensive stroke centers.

Dr. Benitez has written and lectured extensively on Cerebrovascular disease, presenting at national neurosurgical meetings. He authored one of the first papers describing a novel treatment for brain aneurysms with stenting.



STROKE CARE

Atlantic NeuroSurgical Specialists continues to be a leader in the war against stroke. In 2012, Dr. Benitez became one of the first doctors in the country trained on the Trevo[®] Pro Retriever following approval by the FDA. This product is part of a new category of devices known as “stent-trievers.” Unlike prior devices, these stent-trievers allow surgeons to immediately restore blood flow to the patient’s brain by opening up the blockage instantaneously while it is removed from the artery.

Dr. Benitez, a leader in stroke care, has a success rate much greater than the national average. He led the initial group to treat stroke at the first comprehensive stroke center in NJ, which has since expanded to 3 additional centers. Dr. Benitez is continually engaged in clinical trials for new stroke technologies and therapies.



SKULL BASE SURGERY

Dr. Benitez combines traditional and minimally invasive cranial base approaches to allow greater access to tumors along the skull base while minimizing the risks of surgery.
